

## Questions to the employer

During a job interview you will have to answer a lot of questions about yourself. However, take the opportunity to find out more about the company. Below are some examples of questions that you might ask the interviewer.

1. What kind of responsibility does this job involve?
2. What authorities does this job involve?
3. Can you give me some more detailed information about the work involved?
4. How does co-operation work between different functions/departments/operational areas/business areas?
5. What kinds of people and positions are there in the department?
6. Is there a job description for this position?
7. What is the previous occupant of the position now doing?
8. How long did he/she work in the position?
9. What should I know about your company?
10. What are the company's future prospects and visions?
11. Why should I choose to work with you?
12. What are the opportunities for development?
13. How is skills development organised at the company?
14. Does the company hold ongoing personal development and wage discussions?
15. How are these organised?
16. Do you have an induction programme for new employees?
17. What should I know about the working conditions (overtime, travel, etc.)?
